



This exhibition will promote further exploitation of all of these products and prototypes, by showing their applicability to potential end users, conservators, curators, owners and managers of cultural heritage assets. Besides, it will be an opportunity for decision- makers and relevant authorities, as well as the scientific community to learn about the potentially marketable products developed under recent research projects.
