





DISASTER PREPAREDNESS & MITIGATION: 7 STEPS FOR PLANNING

SITE PLAN

(locations of fire stations, streets, parking, woods, etc.)

BUILDING PLAN

SCMRE FIRE ESCAPE ROUTE
LEAVE IMMEDIATELY WHEN ALARM SOUNDS

(fire hydrants, extinguishers, doors & exits, water & elect. turn offs, stairs, security, eye wash, pest strips)

ROOM PLAN

(supplies, sprinklers, windows, carts, kits, phones, computers, fire alarms, etc.)


