#### **Apply Online**

- Go to: https://solaa.si.edu and register for an account
- In SOLAA, select: Program Type: Internship Office/Museum: Smithsonian Center for Learning and Digital Access Program that you wish to apply for: Smithsonian Secretary's Youth Advisory Council (Local Washington D.C. Metro-Area)
- Requires a short essay and the name and e-mail of a teacher, school advisor, or community leader who will provide a recommendation letter by 9/3/2017.
