## HOW TO CONTRIBUTE TO THE LEAF SURVEY

This August, we need you to send us leaves from your community!

**Step 1** - Join the project on **Naturalist** by visiting inaturalist.org or the iNaturalist mobile app (iOS or Android)

What you will need...

A ginkgo tree that is at least 10 ft tall



A smartphone or computer + camera



A large envelope, cardboard, newspaper and tape to mail leaves

Naturalist A free account on iNaturalist

## **Step 2** - Document tree on iNaturalist

- a. Find a tree at least 10ft tall and on public property.
- b. Identify whether the tree is male or female.



Pollen Fleshy structure seeds = =

male female




- c. Take one photo of the entire tree and one of the base.
- d. Post your observation to the Fossil Atmospheres project on iNaturalist.

Step 3 - Collect leaves



Gently remove at least six leaves from a single short shoot (cluster).

**Step 4** - Pack and send your leaves



Make a cardboard ginkgo sandwich.
